MARIANNE MCCAFFREY GREENFIELD: The birth records for Cornelius, Petrus and Benjamin are from the Old Dutch Church, Kingston, NY. There are no birth records there for Anthony or Abraham or any daughters. It is my belief that when the Revolutionary War had ended, William and Henrika, with infant Benjamin, moved from Hurley, Ulster

County to Milford, Otsego County, New York, probably in 1791. Cornelius and Petrus (Peter) may have died in infancy as there is no further mention of them. There was no vital statistic record keeping mandated in the State of New York until 1883/4. There were no churches to record births, deaths and marriages in the wilderness to which they moved. Many Veterans received "bounty land" from the new American government, in lieu of wages they earned in the Patriot Army. William Constable was listed in the record of the Town of Milford, NY Town Meeting in 1798 as a Pathmaster, or road builder. William, Henrika, Benjamin, Anthony and Abraham moved from Milford to the South half of Lot # 96 of the Rapelje Patent, in what is now the Town of Tompkins, Delaware County, in 1814. Henrika Louw Constable applied for a pension after William died, which is on record at the National Archives, Washington, DC. William was Private in the NYS Troops and was injured in a skirmish between a group of Patriots and a band of Indians and Tories in the dense forest of the Shawngunk Mountains. William and Henrika lived adjacent to Benjamin, Anthony and Abraham in the Town of Tompkins, on the 1820 census.

LUCILLE DEWEY: "William Constable first came to Delaware Co. in the 1820's. He was a Revolutionary war veteran and was granted a pension while living in the Town of Tompkins in 1833. He lived to be very old and died between 90 and 100 years of age sometime after 1840. He moved to Delaware County with his wife, unknown, and his 3 sons, Benjamin, Anthony and Abram. All of the Constables from Delaware Co. are related to these 3 brothers. Unknown are the daughters - who changed their names when they were married."

CLEAVER FARM: Marianne McCaffrey Greenfield (Mar 92): As told by my grandfather, Archie Constable, in 1962, this branch of the Constable Family was from Cleaver, Loomis Brook Rd, Town of Tompkins. My mother (Alta McCaffrey) remembers going to Uncle Peter's farm in Cleaver, NY and has pointed out to me where she remembers the farm to be. It is not a town but a collection of houses near Loomis. Peter was a farmer, a Civil War Veteran and Andersonville prison survivor.

CENSUS:

1850 NY Sate census: Peter is listed in Delhi, Delaware, NY as a farmer, 25 years old.

1870 US census: Peter is a farmer with \$1000 in real estate and \$300 in personal property. He couldn't read or write but could vote.

Notes for Phoebe Lucritia Reynolds

Phoebe was named after her grandmother. Phoebe may be from Wales. She was listed in the Delhi, Delaware, NY 1850 census as 25 years old.

OBITUARY: Walton Reporter, 30 Sep 1922: Aaron Phoenix died at his home at Cleaver Thursday morning, Sept. 21, after a lingering illness of many months from cancer. Mr. Phoenix was born in the town of Middletown 73 years ago and while yet a young man his parents, with their children, moved to the farm at Cleaver, where he died. Here he became acquainted with and afterwards married Kate Constable who lived on an adjoining farm. For some years after marriage he worked out around the neighborhood but some forty years ago he returned to his father's farm, putting his savings into the place, and spent the balance of his life's toil upon that farm.

Mr. Phoenix was a tireless worker, a man who knew not the meaning of the word rest. From sun to sun he was everlastingly working and all that time working for the welfare of his family, his only thought; honest, upright and faithful in all his dealings, he was one of the best liked men in that territory of the town of Tompkins. He had a keen interest in everything that went to make the town a success. A Republican in politics, he was no bigot. He could look over the fence and if satisfied he would not hesitate to support the opposition. There was no hypocrisy in his makeup and he was not afraid to express himself freely and never hesitated to ask a question if he did not understand. He was the type of farmer that makes farming worthwhile. He was no dairyman, he was a farmer, and few are the luxuries of today that go on our tables that Aaron Phoenix did not raise on his farm.

He never had nor was he ever known to have a poor crop and all that work, all that energy was for the welfare of his family, whom he dearly loved. His home was always open and the latch string always out.

He leaves to mourn his loss his wife and six children. Thomas at Walton; Nellie, wife of Seymour Shackelton of Cleaver; Gaza, wife of Paul Finch, Beerston road; Georgia, wife of Rev. Curtis Shoup of Callicoon; Colonel on the adjoining farm at Cleaver, and Mrs. Ethel Brundege at home; also two sisters, Mrs. John Gilbert of Bobs brook and Mrs. James Constable of Loomis. The funeral was held at his late residence Monday, conducted by Rev. George Evans, followed by interment in the family plot at Trout Creek.

MARRIAGE: March 30, 1879: "James Constable and Mrs. Anna Phoenix Allen were married in Cannonsville, and instead of taking the customary wedding trip, at once started housekeeping in the little log house on the Constable farm, Loomis brook. The house has long since been replaced by a modern home, and there many of the years of their long married life were spent. They also lived for a time at Third brook and three years ago came to Sidney Center to live with their daughter and family."

60TH ANNIVERSARY: Walton Reporter, 3/31/1939: Thursday, March 30, Mr. and Mrs. James Constable, who live on the Loomis-Northfield road near Loomis, celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary at the home of their daughter and her husband, Mr. and Mrs. Herman Budine. Mr. and Mrs. Budine were married at Cannonsville March 30, 1879, by Rev. W.W. Wetmore at the parsonage of his church. Like Abraham Lincoln, they spent their early married life in a log house on the farm belonging to Mr. Constable's father and located about 3.5 miles from Loomis. 10 or 12 years later they built a new house on the same property, remaining there about 10 years. They then moved to the Herman Henderson farm near Loomis, where they resided about 20 years, moving from there to a farm near their present location. Two years later they occupied the place where they now live. Here they have passed the last 17 years.

Mr. and Mrs. Constable are parents of four sons and a daughter, Andrew and Archie Constable of Third brook; Orrin Constable, who lives near Sidney Center; Ethan, who died about five years ago; and Mrs. Herman Budine of Loomis. Two pleasant dispositions is Mrs. Constable's recipe for a long and happy married existence. "Both husband and wife must have pleasant dispositions to live so many years without more than the usual number of quarrels," said Mrs. Constable. "It takes two to make an argument," she says, "and the best way to avoid it is for one to keep smiling when the other is in a quarrelsome mood."

Mr. and Mrs. Constable's birthdays are only two days apart. Mr. Constable is 79 on the 19th of May and Mrs. Constable is 78 on the 17th of May. They have 23 great-grandchildren and 24 grandchildren. Mr. and Mrs. Constable received a large group of friends, relatives and well-wishers Thursday afternoon at the home of their daughter and son-in-law."

65TH ANNIVERSARY: Walton Reporter, March, 1944, Sidney Center: A family gathering, celebrating the 65th wedding anniversary of Mr. And Mrs. James Constable, was held Thursday at the home of their son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Herman Budine, with 75 relatives and friends present from Walton, Deposit, Cannonsville, Rockdale, Downsville, and Unadilla. Four generations of the family were represented, Mr. Constable, 86, being the oldest present, and his great grandchild, three months-old Evelyn Ann Yarnes, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Richard Yarnes, Walton, the youngest.

The couple received many gifts including money, a large bouquet of American Beauty roses, two decorated anniversary cakes, and about 50 cards.

Notes for Anna Eldia Phoenix

Annie Phoenix was married (first) to Grover Allen, Dec. 24, 1875, when she was only 14 years old. He died of diphtheria sometime during the Spring/ Summer/Fall of 1876. Their son, Ethan (Sam), was born on Dec. 24, 1876. Annie returned home with her infant to live with her parents on a farm adjoining the Constable farm in Cleaver, on the Lower Loomis Brook Rd.

Annie and Aaron Phoenix were brother and sister. Kate Jane and Henry Jemes Constable were brother and sister. It was common for a brother and a sister to marry a brother and a sister on a neighboring farm, to help insure the farms would stay in the family.

Annie and Aaron's father was John Harding Phoenix, a Calico Indian during the Delaware County Anti-Rent War in 1845. He's mentioned in Henry Christman's factual account of the event, 'tin Horns and Calico." He married Margaret Munson on May 13, 1847, after he was released from prison on the Governor's pardon. They lived in Andes before they married then moved to Cleaver where they lived for the remainder of their lives. They are buried in the Carroll Cemetery, Trout Creek. Margaret's maiden name is incorrectly 'davis' on their grave marker.

Annie and "Jim" lived in the house once owned by Ed Bailey, on Upper Loomis Brook Rd. Jim managed the Herm Henderson farm where the Peace Plantation is now located.

MORE: Annie was married, became a mother, and was widowed within one year at age 15! She was married to Grover Allen on December 24, 1875. He died of diphtheria sometime in 1876 before their son, Ethan Allen, was born on December 24, 1876. Her second marriage was to James Henry Constable on March 30, 1879. James Constable's sister Kate Constable married Aaron Phoenix on 25 Feb 1873. Aaron was Annie's brother. Brother and sister married brother and sister.

Walton Reporter, 1960: Unadilla Couple Hurt; He Gets Summons. Gerdon B. Budine, 41, and his wife, Ann, 40, both of Unadilla, R.D. 1, suffered fractured vertebrae Saturday morning when their car was involved in a crash with a tractor-trailer on Route 7 when both vehicles were headed east. Mr. Budine also received a summons for an unsafe turn which is returnable before Town of Afton Justice Arthur Grover. State police at Sidney said that Mr. Budine was heading east when he attempted to make a left turn just as the rig operated by Earl B. Steele, Clayton, attempted to pass. The tractor-trailer was forced into the guardrails and the Budine car went into a ditch.

LEATHERCRAFT: Walton Reporter, January 1972: Leathercraft Work All Began With a Play Kit. A series of mishaps in his life set Gerdon Budine of Unadilla RD 1 on a course which gave him a new hobby and now a major vocation. Their hobby actually started for the Budines in 1969 when Mr. Budine was laid up for a few months with Meniere's disease, an ailment affecting the balancing factor of the inner ear. Their daughter, Kay Roof of Sidney Center, bought him a beginner's kit for leather working. On Jan. 28, 1970, Mr. Budine and his wife, Anne, suffered serious injuries in a traffic accident in Afton vicinity which yielded both of them with broken backs. There followed long.....

At first he shunned the kit with the objection that he is "no artist." But because she cared enough to get it for him he broke into it one day and became a captive artisan. Today Mr. Budine works in leather craft every chance he gets, and with his wife operates Anne's Gift Shop on the Walton-Sidney road near Sidney Center in a small trailer where is also located his tiny workshop. He sounds like a cowboy when he talks about "pounding leather" but that's what it amounts to when Gerdon Budine takes a piece of leather, punch and hammer and starts to fashion a handbag or billfold. Anne assists by working with other offerings of the shop--belts, suede leather articles, decorative items. She also does the lacing on the products of her husband's bench.

Recently, a reporter's attention was drawn to a handbag which had been crafted from leather. It featured a picture of the former Leslie Budine store and filling station once located the corner of Route 10 and the Bob's Brook road. It was

more realistic than the snapshot from which it was taken because this was Gerdon Budine's home ground many years ago.

The Budines find that their hobby not only brings in extra income but it leads to new friendships at the art shows they attend. Next year they plan to do some traveling while the one child remaining at home is in Europe. Along with them, naturally, will be a supply of leather articles.

Customers occasionally have strange requests. One wife had "My love to you, honey" stenciled inside a billfold, Another person in the business of raising goats had a goat placed on his billfold; another person not at all related to the first one also requested the goat picture.

He put a picture of a Franklin church on a key case and a member of the church snapped it up almost before it was completed. Some of the customers include work associates in Department 29 at The Bendix Corporation in Sidney, where Mrs. Budine is also employed.

When seen the other day Mr. Budine was working on the first project he has undertaken for himself. His children gave him a mod type wineskin for Christmas. It has a leather surface so it will now have a new covering with pictures of deer and other animals embossed on it. The Christmas rush is over and he can afford to fool around a little with what started as a hobby performed by a reluctant hobbyist.
